To help us complete school or camp forms in a timely manner, please review the following information before sending us your child's forms.

- 1. To provide the most up-to-date information regarding your child's health needs and medications, an office visit appointment with your child's doctor is required within 6 months of the start date of school or camp.
- 2. A *\$20 fee* will be collected for form completion if it has been more than 6 months since the child's last visit with an Associated Allergist provider.
- 3. To facilitate the prompt return of the requested forms, please fill out your child's **name**, **date of birth**, and **current weight** prior to providing the forms to the office.
- 4. Please let us know if your child is considered physically and emotionally ready to carry their own emergency medications (albuterol, epinephrine auto-injector, Benadryl). After medical review, we will complete this section on the form. Your child should have received documented training/review on the proper use of the medication prior to obtaining medical permission.
- If you would like the forms mailed to you, please provide a self-addressed, stamped envelope. Completed forms cannot be faxed to parents, schools or camps, but can be e-mailed to the parent upon request.
- 6. Please allow 3-5 business days for the staff to complete and return the forms.
